Rothberg International School UK Alumni

Established in 1955, the Rothberg International School now offers a variety of programmes to over 1,200 undergraduate and graduate students annually. Courses combine academic excellence with the opportunity to find intellectual challenge, artistic expression, religious bonds and cultural immersion.

Each year approximately 50 British students participate in these courses and programmes. Studying in the heart of campus, they mix with Israeli students as well as with other students from more than 50 countries around the world, making this part of their life a truly unique experience.

Israeli Hebrew University Alumni Living in Britain

Israeli Hebrew University Alumni who live in Britain comprise 30% of the Alumni Association in the UK. Having obtained a degree from the Hebrew University, they are able to continue their studies at top UK Universities. Others hold high positions in leading high-tech and finance companies and in the diplomatic sector.

The Israeli Hebrew University Alumni form a cohesive community dedicated to strengthening the University and Israel's image in the UK.

Florence Melton Adult Mini School

The Florence Melton Adult Mini-School was founded in 1986. With its international headquarters at the Hebrew University of Jerusalem, it has 65 sites around the world, offering adults the opportunity to acquire Jewish education in an open, trans-denominational, intellectually stimulating learning environment.

The Melton School opened its London offices in October 1998 and now has over 300 graduates, and another 100 students are taking part in the programme this year.

The Melton Alumni continually contribute to the British Jewish community and help promote Israel through the Hebrew University.
